

# How to Use VLC Media Player to Play a CD or DVD

---

## 1. Turn the ITS System ON



## 2. Log in to the resident PC using your netID and ICS Password


## 3. Insert the Disc into the **resident PC tower's** disc drive




## 4. Double click the **VLC shortcut icon** on the desktop



## 5. Click the **Media** Button



6. Select **Open Disc**
7. Choose Either **DVD** or **Audio CD** under **Disc Selection**



8. For **Disc Device**, select the **D drive**.

9. If you would like to start from a specific place in the disc, you can choose a title, chapter, or audio track from this screen.
  - You can also navigate with the time bar at the bottom of the screen above the disc controls.

10. Press **Play**

## TIPS

- To toggle between a video display and a playlist display, press the **Toggle playlist** button on the main screen.
- In this view you can see the tracks on a CD
- Press this button → to enter full-screen mode
- Press this button → to exit full-screen mode
- Click **Playback**, and then **jump to a specific time** to navigate to a specific hour, minute, and second in the media you have selected.
